4 IMPORTANT things to know

- 1** The University of California Regents mandate that all students be covered by a health insurance plan.
- 2** All students are automatically enrolled in the UC Student Health Insurance Plan (UCSHIP) and the premium is charged to their student account.
- 3** If you have comparable insurance and you don't want to keep UCSHIP as dual coverage, you must waive enrollment by 9/1/11.
- 4** All students can use UCSC Student Health Services whether they have UCSHIP or not.

ACCEPT ENROLLMENT

To accept enrollment in UCSHIP no action is necessary. You will automatically be enrolled and billed for the fall quarter premium in August and coverage will begin 9/17/11.

UCSHIP fees 2011-12

\$472 for undergraduates per quarter
(Includes mandatory medical coverage only)

\$889 for graduates per quarter
(Includes mandatory medical, dental and vision coverage)

WAIVE ENROLLMENT

If you opt to waive UCSHIP enrollment for 2011-12, you must complete an on-line waiver confirming you have comparable health insurance coverage by 9/1/11* or you will be charged.

Note: waiver submissions after this deadline, if approved by exception, are subject to a \$50 service fee.

Note: a new waiver **MUST** be submitted each academic year.

HEPATITIS B IMMUNIZATION

Complete the online Hepatitis B Statement (REQUIRED for all new students under 19 years of age on September 17, 2011). Read the important information on other recommended immunizations on our site.
